OSHA Suspends Enforcement of New Silica Rule Until September

Enforcement of the new OSHA rule governing exposure to crystalline silica adopted last year, which was scheduled to go into effect June 23, has been suspended until September 23 in order to allow additional time to provide educational materials and guidance to employers.

Crystalline silica is found in many construction materials - concrete, cement mortar, aggregates, plaster, drywall, and some joint compounds. The new rule limiting exposure to airborne crystalline silica is intended to protect workers from silicosis, a lung disease that results from overexposure to the substance. The new regulation essentially cuts the permissible exposure limit for workers in half. If you have not yet taken steps to comply with the new limits, the delay in enforcement implementation offers another opportunity to prepare. Review safety data sheets of the products you use and look for crystalline silica content, and prepare an exposure control plan for dust generated in construction activities.

Regional News: Savannah's MPC Approves Zoning for Hotel Development Complex

Savannah's Metropolitan Planning Commission recently voted to rezone an eight-acre site south of President Street from Light Industrial to Community Business, in order to accommodate plans for a hotel development complex.

The project is planned to capitalize on proximity to the Savannah River Landing development and is projected for completion in 2023. Developers plan to invest \$250 million in the project.

Plans for removing debris from the site are currently being reviewed by the Georgia Environmental Protection Division. The MPC also voted to approve the conceptual plan for the project, and the zoning change will now move to the Savannah City Council for final approval. Developers will go before the MPC again for approval of general and specific development plans once they are completed.
